

**COLONIAL TO BUCKEYE PIPE LINE PRODUCT COMPATIBILITY TABLE**

The purpose of this table is to identify compatible grade codes for refined petroleum products being transported from the Colonial system to the Buckeye Pipe Line system at Linden, NJ, Paulsboro, NJ and Booth, PA. This table is provided as a general reference tool and may change or be discontinued at anytime without notice. Not all product specification requirements are identical from one pipeline system to another. Shippers are encouraged to verify exact product specifications with the requirements of each company and compare them to the Certificate of Analysis for each batch.
