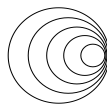

(1) Exception to FERC Tariff No. 28.10.0 Item No. 25: The minimum batch size which will be accepted at Wood River for transportation to these origins shall be 25,000 barrels.

(2) Exception to FERC Tariff No. 28.10.0 Item No. 25: The minimum batch size which will be accepted at Wood River for transportation to St. Louis shall be 2,000 barrels.

(3) Exception to FERC Tariff No. 28.10.0 Item No. 45: A deduction of one-tenth of one percent (0.1%) will be made to cover evaporation, interface losses, and other normal losses during transportation.

(4) Chicago Complex consists of the following locations: East Chicago, Lake County, Hartsdale, Lake County, and Lake George, Lake County. In this table, East Chicago is the applicable location.

(1) The Volume Incentive Rate is available to any shipper subject to the following conditions:

Shipper must execute a Transportation Services Agreement with Wood River in which Shipper commits to ship a minimum average of 3,000 barrels per day, calculated on a quarterly basis, for a twelve-month period (Contract Year).

If a shipper fails to transport the minimum average of 3,000 barrels per day during each 3-month period of the Contract Year, a deficiency charge will be applied which will be equal to the then-current incentive rate from Wood River to Lima as documented in Table 2 times the number of barrels deficient.

Incentive rate applies to all barrels moved.
